PURPOSE: To provide leadership for FPC's Youth Ministry

POSITION REPORTS TO: The pastor, as head of staff

JOB DESCRIPTION: Plan, coordinate, and implement activities of Youth Ministry (including youth fellowship during the school year) into an integrated (fellowship, fun, service, faith exploration) and effective program for youth in grades 6-12. Develop an annual calendar for the Youth Ministry program.

Develop a youth council/committee model of Youth Ministry whereby a team of leaders (adults and youth) are involved in the planning and implementation of program.

Develop, plan, and implement service opportunities for youth. This traditionally has included a week-long trip in the summer.

Serve as a resource for the leaders of the FPC confirmation program, assisting with scheduling and communication.

Establish relationships with parents and others in the FPC congregation to foster support of our Youth Program.

Communicate regularly with FPC youth, their parents, church staff, and the FPC congregation through social media, church publications, and other methods of communication.

Work with the church staff as a member of the team; attend staff meetings as possible; and share in FPC's broader mission and ministry. Maintain close communication with the pastor/head of staff.

The position is part-time (15 to 20 hours weekly). Salary is negotiable, depending on hours and experience.
